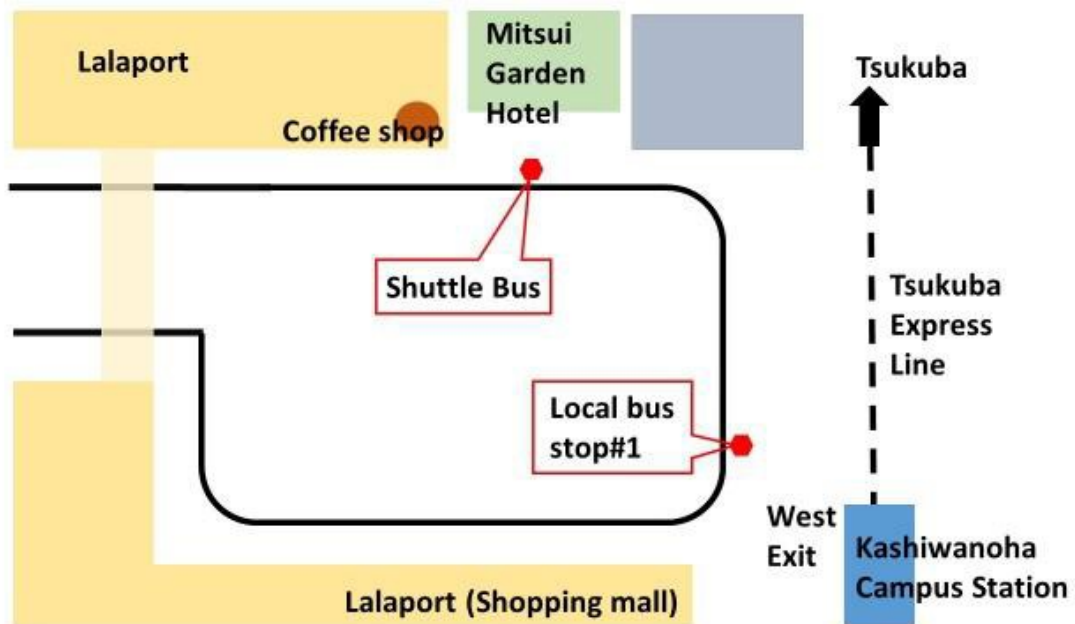


## Directions from Kashiwanoha Campus Station to ISSP



On weekdays, frequent shuttle bus services are available between UTokyo Kashiwa Campus and Kashiwanoha Campus Station. This must be the most convenient mode of transport if you come to ISSP on weekday morning/evening. The service is free to visitors. When you get on the bus, please tell the driver that you are visiting ISSP. At the Kashiwanoha Campus Station, the bus stop (its sign says “Corporate Shuttle”) is located near Tully’s Coffee and Mitsui Garden Hotel.

When the shuttle bus service is not available or inconvenient (weekends and during certain hours), take a Tobu Bus (one-way fare of 170 yen) at the **bus stop #1**. There are three bus stops (stops #1 and 2 for boarding, and the one for alighting only), and the bus stop #1 is the closest to the station, right in front of McDonald’s. (See the map above).

bus stop #1 will take you to **Todai Mae** (東大前[University of Tokyo]), the nearest stop to ISSP.

Get off the bus at the "Todai Mae" and walk across the nearby pedestrian crossing. You will find the main gate of the university right in front of you. Walk along the campus road and pass the guard house, to find the ISSP's main building in front of you to your right. [By Taxi]

The taxi stand is located near the Bus Station #1, in front of the Lalaport shopping mall. Please be informed that most drivers are not familiar with our English abbreviation, ISSP, so please tell them "Tokyo Daigaku Kashiwano-ha Campus." You might want to print out the memo below and show it to the driver. The daytime fare from the station to ISSP is around 1,000 yen.
